Modern cross country at all levels demands the ability to ride accurately and hold straight lines, as well as ride successful curving lines, which is vital for jumping skinnies, arrowhead corners and much more. This training will focus on ensuring you and your horse are looking for the flags and anticipating jumping through narrow spaces, as well as holding lines.

Please read the terms and conditions below. By booking onto a BRC Area 16 training clinic, you agree to these terms and conditions and their contents.

All individuals attending Area Training clinics, must be a member of an affiliated riding club within BRC Area 16.

All bookings must be made via email to Alex Batty at alexfbatty@googlemail.com. Places are not confirmed until BACs payment has been received and a booking is made via email.

Places are on a first come-first served basis.

When requesting your place, please confirm your riding club and a mobile contact telephone number for the member/individual booking on the member's behalf.

All members attending training, are expected to behave in accordance with British Riding Club Code of Conduct. Any member who is in breach of these regulations, will be reported to BRC Head Office

Waiting Lists

If clinics/heights are fully booked, you will be added to a waiting list and contacted should a space become available.

Cancellations and refunds

Should you no longer be able to attend your training clinic, please email Alex **as soon as possible** to request a refund confirming the following details:

Riding Club

Training session you wish to cancel your place

Bank details (for the refund to be processed)

Please note, all refunds will be subject to a cancellation fee of £0.50 per BACs transfer.

If you cancel your space more than 7 days prior to a training session, you will receive a refund (less the cancellation fee) via BACs payment.

If you cancel your space less than 7 days prior to a training session, you will receive a refund (less the cancellation fee) via BACs payment, **only** if your space can be allocated to another member. If your space cannot be filled, you will be liable for 50% of the training cost. If you are eligible for a refund in these circumstances, this will be processed following the training date in question.

If you cancel your space less than 48 hours prior to a training session, you will not be eligible for a refund. Apologies, we are unable to accept any exceptions to this rule.

We appreciate that horses are unpredictable, and that circumstances can change for horse and rider between booking and the training. However, we ask that you notify Alex as soon as you become aware you are unable to attend, so your place can be offered to other members. We operate waiting lists for many of the BRC Area clinics, so there may be other members able to utilise your space.
